Position Description for

President

General duties for all Board members:

- 1. Understand and demonstrate a commitment to the organisation's mission and programs
- 2. Keep up to date with issues and trends that affect the organisation
- 3. Prepare for meetings by reading agendas, minutes, reports and other documentation required to actively participate in them
- 4. Attend Board meetings regularly
- 5. Contribute skills and knowledge by participating actively in meetings and committee work
- 6. Make inquiries when clarification or more information is needed
- 7. Understand and monitor the organisation's financial affairs
- 8. Avoid any potential conflicts of interest
- 9. Understand and maintain confidentiality
- 10. Ensure the organisation is complying with all legal and regulatory requirements

Specified duties for President:

- 1. Is a partner with the Secretary-General in achieving the APDSC's mission
- 2. Provides leadership to the Board of Directors, who sets policy and to whom the Secretary-General is accountable
- 3. Develops agendas for Board/Congress meetings with the Secretary-General
- Chairs meetings of the APDSC Executive Committee
- 5. Recommends to the board which committees (commissions) are to be established
- 6. Seeks volunteers for committees and coordinates individual board member assignments
- 7. Appoints the chairpersons of committees, in consultation with Secretary-General and other board members
- 8. Serves ex officio as a member of committees and attends their meetings when invited
- 9. Ensures that board matters are handled properly, including committee functioning, recruitment of new board members, orientations, and meeting preparation
- 10. Discusses issues confronting the APDSC with the Secretary-General
- 11. Helps guide and mediate board actions with respect to APDSC's priorities and governance concerns
- 12. Reviews with the Secretary-General any issues of concern to the board
- 13. Monitors financial planning and financial reports
- 14. Evaluates the performance of the Secretary-General and the effectiveness of the board members

32 Members of APDSC:

- 15. Annually evaluates the performance of the APDSC in achieving its mission and objectives
- 16. Speaks and represents the APDSC to the media during the AP Deaf Games/Championships
- 17. Annually reviews matters of governance that relate to the board's structure, role, and relationship to AP members
